

Display Clarifications

Horticulture Display

The horticulture display will be on a rotating theme from the years 2009-2013. The themes are as follows:

Themes:

- A. Interiorscape – Live Plants -2009
- B. Annual Garden – Bedding or Vegetables-2010
- C. Floriculture – Live Plants or cut flowers-2011
- D. Perennial Garden-2012
- E. Floriculture –Artificial Plants or cut flowers-2013

Interiorscaping- Enhances indoor appearance by providing a natural garden atmosphere.

Size: 5' deep, 9' facing, and 8' max height, no table top displays

Landscaping Display

The Landscaping Display should apply the basic principles of landscape design, construction, and maintenance.

All landscapes should include an original scale drawing of the displayed area. The scale used should be 1 inch = 1 foot on a 24"x18" paper for proper display purposes. A plant list and title block must be included.

Size: 8' deep, 15.5' facing

Delaware Ag Products Display

The Delaware Ag Products Display should present the importance of Delaware Agriculture and convey Delaware Agriculture in a positive sense.

Size: 5' deep, 9' facing, and 8' max height

Educational Display

The educational display should provide valuable information related to some area of agriculture.

The educational display will be on a rotating theme from the years 2009-2013. The themes are as follows:

Themes:

- F. Environmental Science -2009
- G. Animal Science-2010
- H. Biototechnology-2011
- I. Leadership/FFA- 2012
- J. Current Agriscience Issue- 2013

Size: Table top Display- 8'x4'

Ag Products Exhibit Scoring Sheet

OVERALL APPEARANCE AND VARIETY WITHIN
